

## **Criteria for Educational Subsidies**

### **1. The applicant has to:**

- i) be a member in good standing of the PSAC in Ontario
- ii) apply for subsidy to a labour oriented course or training
- iii) apply for a course offered by, the Canadian Labour Congress (CLC); Occupational Disability Response Team (ODRT); or Worker's Health and Safety Centre, Work place Safety Insurance Board (WSIB)
- iv) apply to a co-sponsored or co-subsidized course which will have priority over other requests
- v) apply to an educational course offered by the PSAC which will be considered subsequent to (iv)

### **2. The REO will report to:**

- i) Education Committee quarterly on approved applicants

## **UPDATED OCTOBER 2009**

### **1: The applicant has to:**

- ii) be a member in good standing of the PSAC in Ontario
- iii) apply for subsidy to a labour oriented **learning event**
- iv) apply for a course offered by, the Canadian Labour Congress (CLC); Occupational Disability Response Team (ODRT); or Worker's Health and Safety Centre, Work place Safety Insurance Board (WSIB)
- v) apply to a co-sponsored or co-subsidized course which will have priority over other requests
- vi) apply to an educational course offered by the PSAC which will be considered subsequent to (iv)
- vii) **Requests for a subsidy should be submitted to the PSAC Regional Office for recommendation. The Regional Office consult with the respective geographic regional council member(s) prior to making a recommendation**
- viii) **Once recommended, the request should be submitted to the Regional Education Officer for approval. The REO shall consult with the chair of the Regional Council Education Committee prior to approving the request**

### **2: The REO will report to:**

- ix) Education Committee quarterly on approved applicants
