

Important questions you need to ask management in your workplace



Given the government's announcements, what impact does management expect the announced cuts to have on our workplace, if any?

Does management have any changes planned with respect to staffing in the workplace, such as the use of attrition, reductions in positions, etc.?

If there are plans to leave positions vacant, who will take on the additional workload? How will the work get done?

Is management aware of its obligations under our collective agreement, particularly with respect to the job security provisions?

For additional questions to ask management, depending on what is communicated by the employer in meetings with management, the questions listed in the member/steward report card – *What's going on in your workplace?* – can also be used as a guide.

If management does indicate that changes are planned, it will be important that the union indicate up front that we will be enforcing our rights, and that PSAC will be taking steps to protect the services that we provide.
