A bit about Sharp

T. Sharp Dopler is a two-spirit Indigenous educator and traditional knowledge keeper. Sharp have been educating people about diversity issues for over 20 years, including issues around Indigenous history and colonisation, ability, LGTBTTIQ2A and women's issues. Sharp has presented at local, provincial, national and international venues. Sharp has been out as a lesbian since 1982 and identifies as non-binary gender – in the Ojibwe language- agokwe-nini or ogichidaa kwe. Sharp has a diploma in Social Service work and worked with an Indigenous HIV/AIDS agency for 10 years. Sharp also has a Master's degree in Canadian Studies. Sharp recently became a consultant, establishing a sole proprietorship company- [Sharp Solutions](#). Sharp recently presented at the International HIV/AIDS conference in Durban South Africa from July 12-23, 2016.
