REGIONAL CONVENTIONS 2017

Call for Nominations for Regional Executive Vice-President and Alternate Regional Executive Vice-President *Ontario Region*

This is the official call for nominations for the position of Regional Executive Vice-President and Alternate Regional Executive Vice-President for the Ontario Region (and second Alternate if passed by Convention). Elections for these positions will be held at the Ontario Regional Convention in Mississauga, Ontario, May 26th – May 28th, 2017

A nominations Form is attached to this letter.

Delegates to the 2017 PSAC Ontario Region Convention, being held May 26th – May 28th, 2017 in Mississauga, Ontario will be electing the Ontario Regional Executive Vice-President (REVP) and their Alternate (and second Alternate if passed by Convention). Any PSAC member in good standing in the Ontario Region is entitled to run for these positions. The nominator and the seconder must be delegates to the Ontario Region Convention.

As Regional Coordinator, I have been assigned the responsibility for sending out the call for nominations, receiving the nominations in advance of the Regional Convention, and working with the Nominations Committee at the Convention itself.

Here's how the procedure will work, and what to do if you want to run for office or nominate someone to run for office.

Nominations Procedure

A Nominations Committee will be appointed by the Ontario Regional Council and ratified on the Convention floor. The Chairperson of the Nominations Committee will be appointed by the Regional Council and will conduct the elections for the positions of REVP and Alternate REVP (and second Alternate if passed by

convention). The Chairperson has the power to appoint scrutineers and assistants deemed necessary to conduct the elections in an orderly manner.

In my capacity as Regional Coordinator, I have been tasked with facilitating the nomination process in advance of the Convention. I am also responsible for ensuring that the nominations are filed with the Nominations Committee in writing, signed by the nominator and seconder, each of whom must be an accredited delegate to the Ontario Regional Convention.

Eligibility for Office

Candidates nominated for the position of REVP and Alternate REVP (and second Alternate if passed by convention) do not have to be a delegate to the Convention, but must be a member in good standing and live or work in the Ontario Region. However the nominator and seconder must be delegates to the Ontario Regional Convention.

Submitting the Nomination Form

You will find attached a Nomination Form for the position of Regional Executive Vice-President and Alternate Regional Executive Vice-President.

Nominees who will not be present at the Regional Convention must submit a nomination form to me prior to the start of the Regional Convention.

Nominees who will be present at Convention can submit a nomination form to me prior to the start of the Regional Convention, to the Nominations Committee during Convention, or be nominated from the floor at the Regional Convention.

Access to Lists

All declared candidates for the positions of REVP and Alternate REVP are entitled to receive:


- **Two sets of mailing labels** (hard copy) of the registered delegates and registered observers to the Regional Convention. Regional Coordinators can either send declared candidates the two sets of mailing labels or have the declared candidate pick them up at the Regional Office.
- **An electronic list of the names of registered delegates and registered observers** (in PDF format), with the Component or DCL affiliation (in PDF format)

Declared candidates will not be provided with the emails and/or phone numbers of the delegates and observers.
