- -May 5 last week was of course Red Dress Day and there are still some ongoing events for that for May, so please keep your ears open for that in your area. Please

take some time to learn about missing and murdered indigenous women, girls and 2S folks if you haven't already.

- -It's also Asian Heritage Month! The theme for 2025 is "Unity in Diversity: The Impact of Asian Communities in Shaping Canadian Identity". This month is a time to learn about and appreciate the cultures and traditions that Asian communities have brought to Canada.
